<sup>1</sup> MOSH and MOAH content must be respected for all ingredients derived from petroleum and used in inks.

<sup>2</sup> Mineral oils are complex hydrocarbon substances (composed of hydrogen and carbon molecules) produced by the refining of crude oils. They contain MOSH (Mineral Oil Saturated Hydrocarbons) and MOAH (Mineral Oil Aromatic Hydrocarbons). MOSH are composed of linear, branched and / or cyclic carbon chains, and MOAH of aromatic compounds.

<sup>3</sup> C20-C30 refers to compounds whose carbon chains are between 20 and 30 carbon atoms.
